STATS

1 in 44 children in the U.S. are diagnosed with autism

Due to a lack of access to critical resources, this number is likely much higher.

2-year wait time for a diagnosis

In our region, because of the complexity of autism spectrum disorder, the therapies, interventions, and services are scarce. Once diagnosed, children wait even longer to receive these therapies.

134 miles to the nearest site for a comprehensive autism evaluation


Currently, traveling to Billings or Missoula is the only option for a comprehensive autism evaluation.

Average cost for care for someone with autism

Costs associated with having a child with autism can be **\$60,000 a year**, with the bulk of these costs in special services and lost wages related to increased demands on one or both parents. Mothers who tend to serve as the child's case manager and advocate are less likely to work outside the home. On average, they work fewer hours per week and earn 56 percent less than mothers of children with no health limitations and 35 percent less than mothers of children with other disabilities or disorders. -Autism Speaks
